HSC Requirements

To be considered for entry to the Highland Soccer Club please fill the application and sign at the bottom of the page to verify your understanding of the requirements of the club and your commitment to fulfill the obligations of the club and the Morris County Youth Soccer Association (MCYSA).

Note: To bring a team into the club and register with the MCYSA there must be at least one coach who has a state sanctioned license, minimum license – “F” (E – Preferred).

ALL coaches must be licensed before taking to the practice field or game field with their team.

2. What age team will you be bringing into the club?

The minimum cost for a new team to enter the HSC is:

U8 – 10: \$605 (The state of NJ requires that a minimum of 8 Players are required to register a team)

U11: \$635 (The state of NJ requires that a minimum of 8 Players are required to register a team)

Membership dues are \$50/player, the above amounts are minimums that are required to cover potential penalties levied on the club in the event that your team folds after being registered in the MCYSA.

Notes:

- a. The cost to register a team with the MCYSA is as follows:



U8 – U10: \$105
U11 and Up: \$135

- b. The cost of team registration is covered by the club out of membership dues (\$50/player), however, the penalty for backing out after a team is registered is not. The MCYSA will charge the HSC the following penalties which will be charged to your team if the team pulls out after being registered. These penalties will be deducted from your teams initial minimum registration fee, depending on the penalty, the remaining monies will be refunded minus a \$50 administration fee.

From Section 3.5 in the MCYSA bylaws:

- A team will be fined \$150 for dropping out after being registered before the publication of final flighting by the MYCSA.
- A team will be fined \$250 after final flighting is published but before the season starts.
- A team will be fined \$500 for dropping out after the start of play.

The deadline to register a new team for the Fall 2004 season is July 15th, 2004, will you have enough players to register a team?

Please do not register a team if you don't have at least the minimum required by the State of New Jersey.

A team CAN'T register until a written approval of acceptance is given by the club and the appropriate minimum fees have been paid. This acceptance is contingent upon the team meeting all the HSC, MCYSA and NJYSA requirements and can be revoked if these guidelines are not met. If acceptance is revoked due to the team not meeting all the requirements, the team is still responsible for any fines and penalties.

3. HSC and MCYSA Bylaws:

The HSC has bylaws that all teams must abide by, these are available for download from the Highland Soccer Web site (www.highlandsoccer.com)



As a member of the MCYSA the HSC is also required to follow the bylaws of their league. These bylaws can be downloaded from www.mcysa.org.

4. Practice fields:

The club has game and practice fields available for use by the teams. These fields are in various locations of Green, Andover, and Newton. If you do not have a practice field available the club will provide a field with practice times. Please note that teams that have been in the club for a year or more will get scheduling preference over the new team. All of the fields require regular maintenance which includes stringing nets, anchoring goals, lining fields, making sure that there are enough corner markers available, etc. Since the club is a community we need to have as many people as possible involved with keeping the fields in good shape. This is done on a volunteer basis.

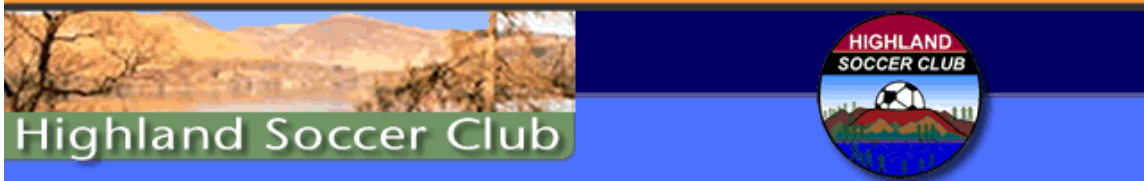
5. Uniforms and Equipment

Uniforms:

One of the charters of the HSC is that we are developing players for the Newton High School soccer program, as a result our clubs uniform colors are the same, Maroon and White.

The HSC has available sources for low cost equipment such as:

- Uniforms
- Warm-up suits
- Team Bags



There is no requirement to purchase uniforms from the club, however, if you do choose to purchase your own uniforms the colors must comply the HSC requirements.

NOTE: Whether or not you purchase uniforms through the club's preferred vendor or not, ALL monies to purchase uniforms need to run through the club's treasurer. Parent's are to make checks payable to the Highland Soccer Club and the HSC will pay the invoice when due. In the event your vendor requires you to pay with a credit card, the parents will still pay the HSC and the coach will be reimbursed through his/her team's account once an invoice is presented to the Treasurer.

Equipment:

The HSC provides each team with practice balls and (2) Game balls for each season. The practice balls are to be kept until your team either goes to the next age (ball size) or decides to leave the club at which time they will be returned.

6. Roster:

Attach a player roster to this application. Roster should include player's first and last name, address and birth date. Also indicate whether the player's parents have made a commitment to your proposed team.

NOTE: New teams can not recruit players from an already existing HSC team without the prior consent of the coach from that team. It should not be the intentions of the new coach to destroy the makeup of an already existing team. Any player/coaching disputes will be decided by the HSC Board or Directors.

NOTE: A minimum of 75% of your players must reside within the towns of Andover, Green and Newton for all teams up to U14. For teams U15 and up the minimum percentage is 50%. Also, the majority of your players must be of the proper age for your team. IE. If you are forming a U10 team and have 10 players, at least 6 of them must be of "true" U10 age as defined in the MCYSA handbook.
